2016 Statutory Test Results as at 1 November 2016

Here are our results for the End of Foundation Stage, Year 1 Phonics Screening Check in Year 1, the End of Key Stage 1 SATs in Year 2 and the End of Key Stage 2 SATs in Year 6.

The introduction of the new more challenging National Curriculum and the abolition of "levels" for Year 2 and Year 6 in 2015-16 means that these results cannot be compared to previous years. Please see the explanation given in the Department for Education's publication on the front page of our website (www.highfieldprimary.co.uk) "National curriculum assessments at Key Stage 2 in England, 2016 (interim) dated 5 July 2016. We are still awaiting some national figures to make final comparisons.

However, these results are again outstanding, with pupils at Highfield Primary School generally in line or above their national peers. We are delighted that given the higher standards and expectations high attainment and achievement has been sustained.

We would like to thank the pupils, parents/carers and our staff for contributing to this great success.

National comparisons

Nationally schools are ranked in percentiles.

In Reading Highfield is placed in the 3rd percentile; in Writing in the 8th percentile and in Maths in the 9th percentile, meaning in combined subjects Highfield is in the top 10% of schools nationally in terms of progress.
