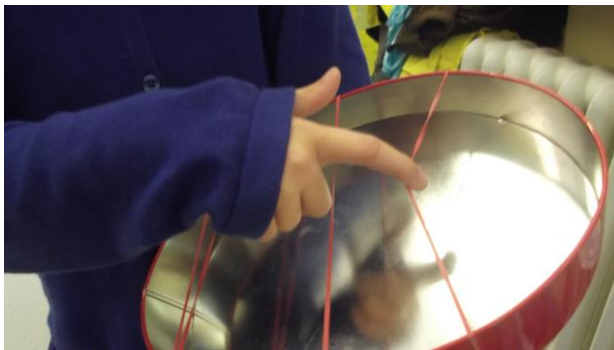


Highlights of the Year – 5LW
