We can use secondary sources to make some predictions about what Llandudno will be like before we actually visit.

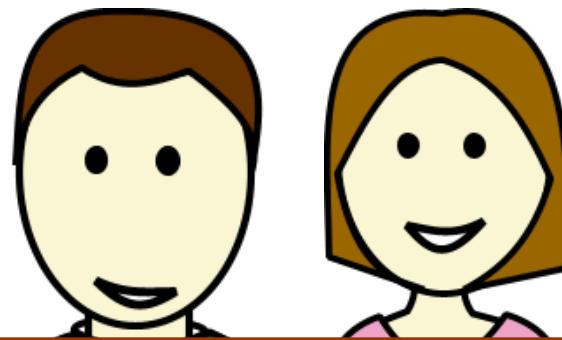

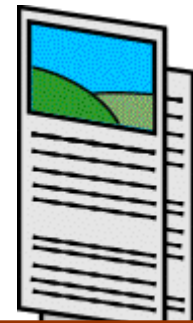
The internet

Make notes and take photographs of the things you see and do in Llandudno.

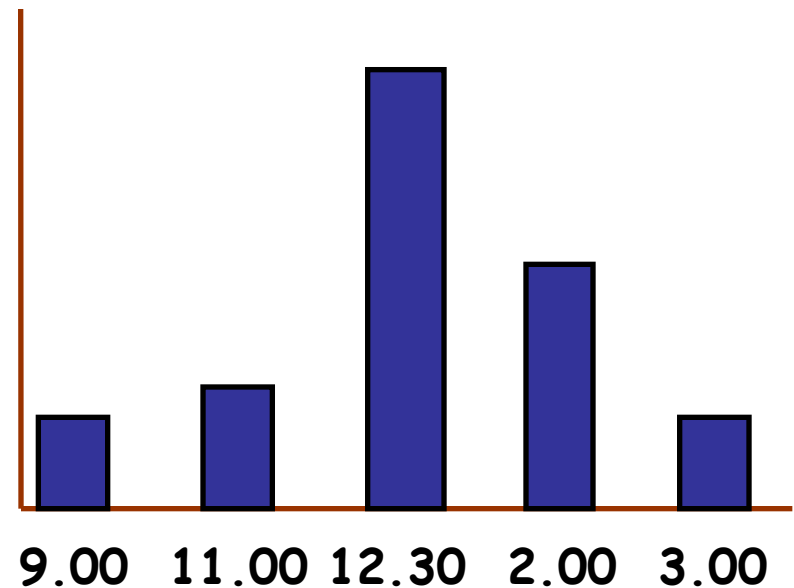
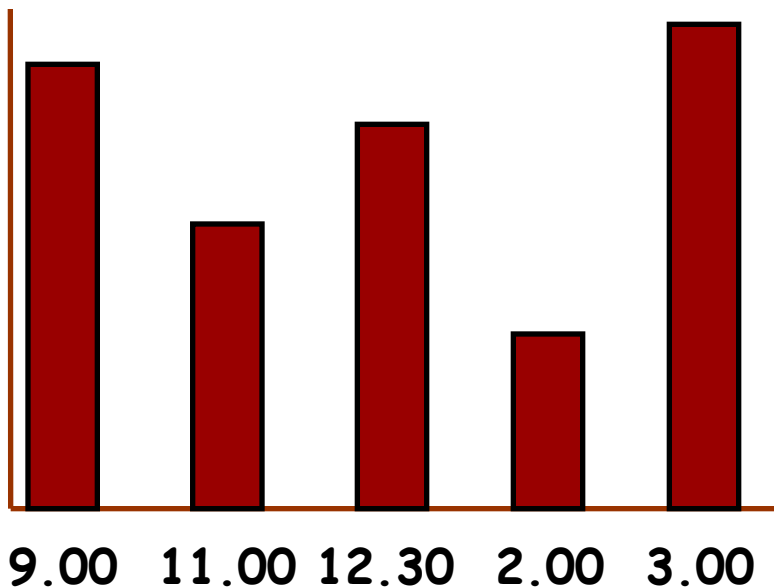
You will then be able to compare what Llandudno is really like with the predictions you made before the visit.
