Focus areas for 2013-14

- To sustain and improve reading in Reception and Year 1 including systematic teaching of synthetic phonics
- To narrow gaps in achievement between all groups of pupils

- To adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of all pupils
- To provide a stimulating and engaging Creative Curriculum which allows opportunities to transfer skills across other curriculum areas

PUPILS' BEHAVIOUR AND SAFETY

- Ensure that pupils' attendance is in line national average
- To promote the safety of pupils beyond the school environment
