# Schools in England are facing the biggest cuts in a generation

The money following your child into school is going down.

This will mean:

- increased class sizes
- loss of teaching and support staff
- fewer subject choices
- fewer resources and out of school activities



In addition, introducing a new school funding formula without the money to deliver it means that all schools are losing out.

The Impact on Enfield Schools by 2019 (*figures per [www.schoolcuts.org.uk](http://www.schoolcuts.org.uk)*)

- **£29 million less budget by 2019**
- **£554 less per pupil**
- **Equates to 735 less teachers**
