We made the decision to send our daughter to a non-selective school that truly reflects the local community. Another nearby school has detrimentally affected the congregation size of other N21 churches due to its selection policy. I wouldn't be happy for my child to be in such an elitist environment. The caring, inclusive atmosphere at Highfield is really superb.

I wrote a letter of complaint regarding my child not being able to have any warm food for lunch. He spent 4 years on packed lunches due to him being vegan. My hopes and expectation was for him to be able to have beans on toast, chips, maybe even a jacket potato here and there. One year later, Heru is still so happy on school dinners. Being able to have school dinners not only provided him with warm lunches, it has also enabled him to make friends and play with different children that he would not usually have befriended whilst on packed lunch as they are on different sittings. It has also enabled me to save time in the mornings and save money instead of purchasing items for lunches daily. I am writing this letter because I am commending Naz (the school cook). Her services have been over and beyond that what was expected of her. Many times she has gone out of her way to make things, like pastries and desserts that are specifically for my child. This is unexpected and we are very appreciative and touched by her kindness. I want to say a big thank you to Naz and to Highfield for being so accommodating. This is a fantastic school and i never cease to sing it's praises. The outstanding report by Ofsted is more than deserved.
