(Articles 15 and 30)

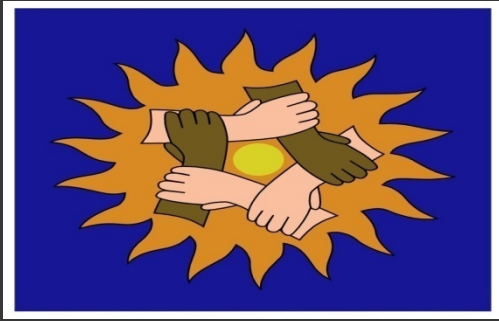
Draw a picture which shows what friendship means to you.

We talk at meetings

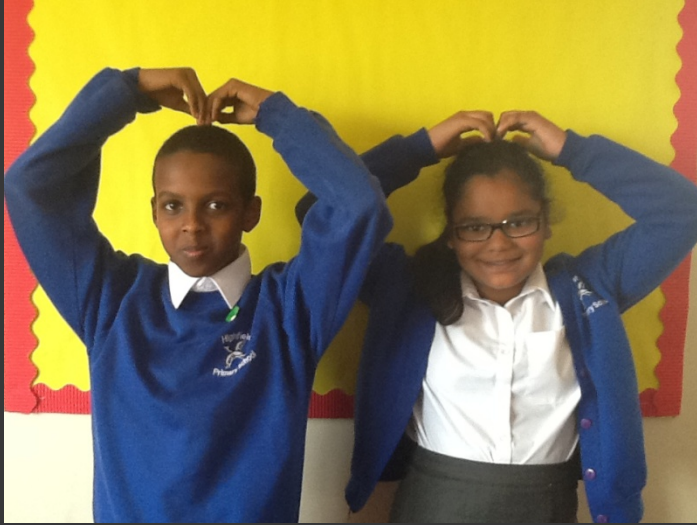
Number 6

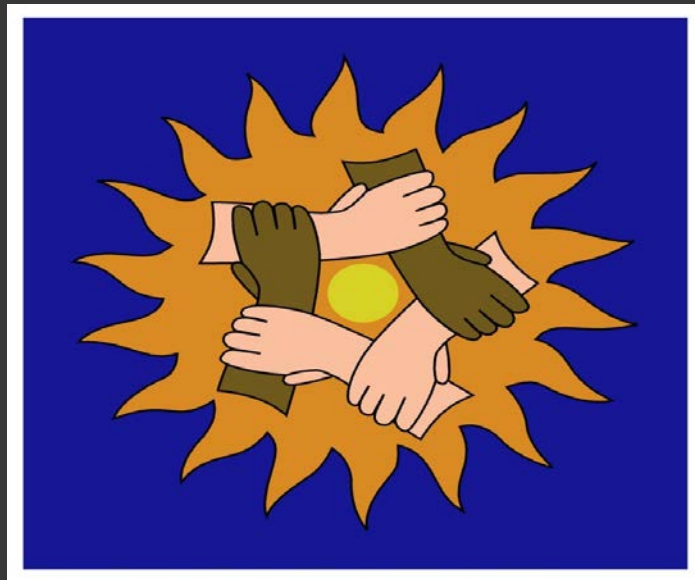
