Maths: This term we will be covering all the main areas in maths including number, shape, data handling and measures. The children will apply their knowledge within these areas to help them solve contextualised/real life problems. Year 4 Curriculum News

Topic: Rulers and Governments

Science: Our topic for this half term is Sound. We will be looking at how sound travels, where it comes from and how we can change it. After half term our topic will be Animals, including humans. We will be constructing food chains, learning about the digestive system and the function of teeth.

English: So far this term we have focused on Stories set in imaginary worlds where the children are looking at different types of descriptive language. We will also be writing poetry, information texts, newspapers and other types of stories. Through these writing forms the children will learn to organise their writing, use descriptive language, present facts and opinions and use grammar effectively.

Religious Education: The children will be exploring Hinduism this term. We will be having a Religious Education Week where we will be looking at creations stories, specifically for The Hindu belief.

Art, Design & Music: This Term in music we will have the opportunity to appreciate, listen to and compose music in a variety of forms. Art will be linked closely to our History unit, The Romans. We will be creating a Roman Banquet for our Roman Theme day as well as a Roman Sculpture using clay.

ICT: This half term we will be creating a class database where the children will use a program called Purple Mash. The children will make their own surveys which they will then input into a database.
