# Year 6 Curriculum News Topic: Fit for Life This Term's Value: Determination

### History/Geography:

Our topic this term is 'The Mayans' with particular reference to comparing the Mayan civilisation c.AD900 with the Benin AD 900-1300. The children will be following a line of enquiry to compare these two different non-European societies

**French:** We will be learning how to say, read and write about the weather and after half term the focus will be sports and sporting activities.

### English:

This term we will be writing an alternate ending to Kensuke's Kingdom. The children will also be writing an explanation text on the circulatory system and will be writing their final newspaper, which will be titled Bye Highfield! Additionally, the children will be having a weekly spelling and punctuation lesson to help improve their writing.
