

## School Uniform

Jewellery - In the interest of safety no jewellery should be worn.

(The only exception is plain stud earrings or religious jewellery to be worn under shirt)

- No Nail Polish
- Trainer must be all black (no Nike ticks)

#### **Girls**

black or grey trousers, pinafore or skirt white polo shirt or white shirt royal blue cardigan or sweatshirt or fleece plain black, grey or white socks or tights royal blue/white check summer dress black shoes (heels no higher that 2.5cm)

#### Boys

black or grey trousers white polo shirt or white shirt royal blue sweatshirt or fleece plain black, white or grey socks black shoes

## Weekly Routine
