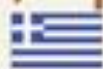

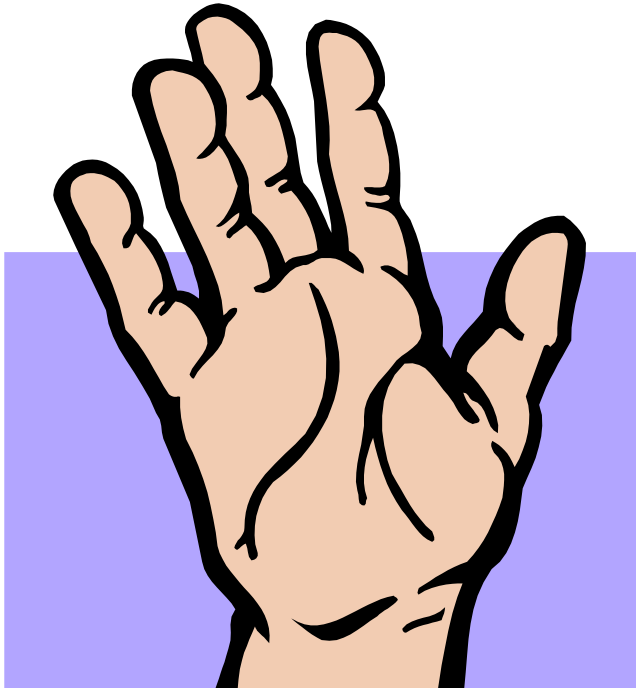

How do I help my child?

- Read with your child 10 -15 minutes every night
- Spellings – look, cover, write ,check
- Sit with you child while they do their homework
- Practical mathematics activities
- Practise the 2, 5 and 10s timetables
- Tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.
