- Finding one more and less of a number.
- Recognising common 2D shapes.
- Writing numbers in words and digits up to 20.
- > Number bonds to 10.

### Science:

Our Science topics this term are Plants, Seasonal Changes, The Human Body and Our Senses. We will be labelling parts of the body, identifying the senses and learning about different parts of plants.

# **Religious Education:**
