English:

Maths: This term we will be covering all the main areas in maths including number, geometry, statistics and measures. The children will apply their knowledge to investigative and problem-solving activities.

Year 4 Curriculum News

Topic: Step back in Time.

French: Our topic this term is *Portraits* and through this unit the children will be learning to describe theirs and others' appearance and personalities.

PE: Outdoor PE lessons will focus on net and invasion games, and indoor sessions will focus on gym and balance.

History/Geography: study of Roman Britain with a focus on Emperor Claudius' invasion and legacy. After half term we will then look at the effects of the Roman demise and the subsequent Anglo Saxon invasions.

Science: Our topic for this half term is *All Living Things and their Habitats*. We will be looking at local habitats in and around the school. After half term our topic.

Religious Education: The children will be exploring Judaism and the celebration of Sukkot. As part of the unit, they will have the opportunity to visit a local synagogue and meet with the Rabbi.

Art, Design: After half term we will look at the design and manufacture of Anglo-Saxon jewellery. We will then use the patterns to make brooches in clay.

Music: This term the children will be learning to read sheet music and to play the Recorder. Lessons will be lead by the Enfield Music Service.

ICT/D&T: This term the ICT focus is software development. We will learn to design, write and debug programs and will also spend some time on learning how to use the internet for research purposes.
