Please ensure your child is at school by 8.50am and we will return to school for normal collection time at 3.20pm. We will be leaving school promptly after registration to travel to the museum by underground and overground train. There is no cost for this trip, children are allowed to bring no more than £5 to spend at the museum shop. If you would like to join Year 3 on this trip, please let the class teacher know as soon as possible.

Children will require a packed lunch and must be in correct school uniform. As the journey involves walking, children must be dressed warmly. Packed lunches must be in a plastic bag which we will dispose of after they have eaten (no lunchboxes, glass bottles, canned drinks or sweets). Please also note that nuts should not be brought due to nut allergies.

Year 3 will be having an Ancient Egyptian day on Thursday 6th December 2018. Children should come to school dressed as an Ancient Egyptian; be as creative as you can! During the day we will be eating an Ancient Egyptian feast, therefore we are asking for a **£1 donation** to contribute to this.
