



### Don't Forget



## Year 2 Curriculum News Spring 2019 Topic: Active Planet



### Maths will include:

- Place value
- Writing numbers in words and digits up to 100
- Fractions
- Counting in steps of 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s from 0
- Counting backwards and forwards in 10s from any number
- Recall and use 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Developing a variety of strategies for calculating, including jotting, drawing number lines and partitioning

### Religious Education:

This term we will be focusing on Christianity and how children learn about their faith. Children will be learning about Sikhism for the first time, focusing on the birth and teachings of Guru Nanak.

### English will include:

- Recount
- Narrative
- Grammar and punctuation
- Spelling

Our key focus this term is ensuring that children's grammar is correct and that they are developing skills in editing and improving their work. Children are learning alternative phonemes and rules for adding suffixes. We will be basing our writing on 'Grace and Family' and 'The Emperor's Egg'.

### Topic:

Our theme this term is 'Active Planet'. The children have already brought in some fantastic homework for this topic and our classrooms look amazing! We will be linking our Science and Geography work to this topic.

### PHSE:

In PHSE we will be focusing on keeping ourselves safe, linking this to computing and Science.

### Science:

Our Science topics this term are 'Materials' and 'Habitats'. We will be learning about bulbs and how they grow. We will be looking at different habitats and linking this to our Geography topic.

### Computing

We will continue to focus on E-safety in Computing. The children will be taught how to send an email with an attachment using Purple Mash. Also they will be learning how to use a graphing program.
