Expressive Arts and Design:

We will look at changes as they occur within the seasons, and different festivals as they arise. As we observe the children, different topics relating to our world and class will become apparent. As part of our whole school topic, we would like each child to bring in a photo of them as a baby, for us to talk about and display.

Nursery Curriculum News

Whole school topic: The Circle of Life.

Whole school value: Mindfulness.

Mathematics:

We will be working on a range of concepts, including:

- Counting.
- Sorting.
- Matching.
- Shapes.
- Patterns.
- Sizes.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be concentrating on settling children into school, learning school rules and routines and making our own class rules.

The children will get to know each other and different members of staff.

We will be working on sharing and taking turns. Children will also be developing their independence and taking responsibility for managing their own needs, such as going to the toilet and putting on coats.

Communication and Language:

We will be concentrating on developing:

- Listening skills.
- Communicating clearly with others.
- Speaking in full sentences.
- Using correct vocabulary.

Physical Development:

Children will have daily access to the outside areas, developing their gross motor skills. Fine motor skills will be developed through cutting and sticking, puzzles, modelling with playdough and construction equipment.

Literacy:

We will focus on:

- Enjoying a variety of stories, both individually and in small groups.
- Joining in with nursery rhymes and poems.
- Mark-making, including practising writing names.
- Tuning in to sounds, following the Letters and Sounds program.
