- Please make a comment about your child's reading in their reading record.


Maths will include:


- Place value

Topic: Secret Spaces and Curious
Collections

Value: Selflessness



Science:

Our Science topics this term are 'Materials and 'Plants'.

We will be learning about bulbs and how they grow. We will be looking at different materials and their uses.

English will include:

- Recount
- Narrative
- Grammar and punctuation
- Spelling

Our key focus this term is ensuring that children's grammar is correct and that they are developing skills in editing and improving their work. Children are learning alternative phonemes and rules for adding suffixes. We will be basing our writing on 'Grace and Family' and 'The Emperor's Egg'.
