

## *Tapestry Ideas - Upload what you have done onto Tapestry*

### Linked to whole school theme - Bright Lights, Big City

Create a blossom tree using cotton buds and paint.

Explore Japanese arts and crafts and famous artists such as Sesshu Toyo, Ogata Korin, or Katsushika Hokusai.

Learn some basic Japanese words and phrases.

Design an Olympic mascot.

Taste test or make some Japanese food such as sushi, miso soup or ramen noodles.

Make a kakejiku (hanging scroll) and decorate it with a painting or shodo (Japanese calligraphy).

Create a model of your favourite London landmark - lego/ junk/ construction/ newspaper etc. Explain why you chose that landmark.

Research popular London landmarks and make a poster with key facts. (Encourage your child to use their phonic knowledge and use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.)

### Linked to EYFS

Bake/ cook with a family member

Using a form of technology to take photos of 'interesting items' in your home and explain why they have been chosen.

Do a jigsaw puzzle

Choose your favourite toy/ thing to play with. Explain why it is your favourite.
