Fire Imp

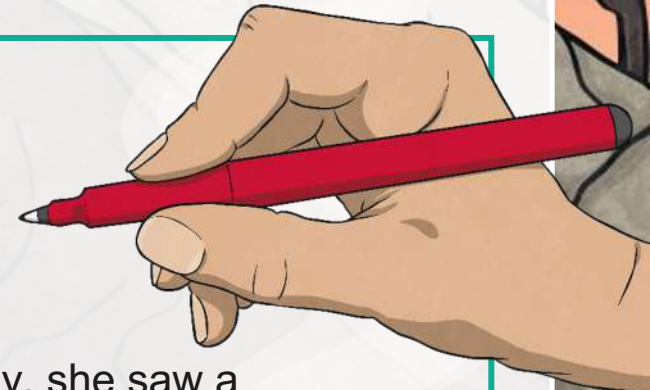
Scene: In Razvani's grotto.

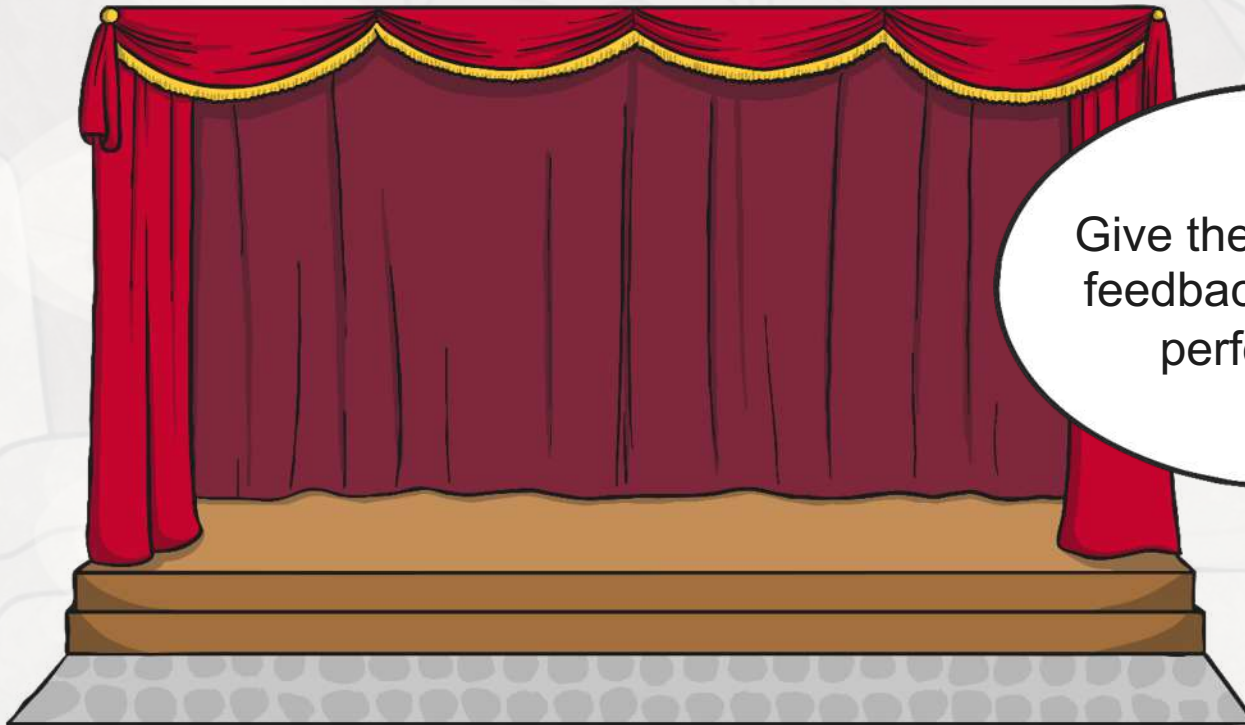
