Anti-

Auto-

A prefix is added to the beginning of a word to make a new word. Most prefixes are added to the beginning of root words without any changes in spelling. **Like this:**







What is a Prefix?



What does the prefix **super** mean?

supernatural	Greater than normal natural powers.
superhero	Cartoon character that has extraordinary powers.
supernova	A star that suddenly increases greatly in brightness because of a catastrophic explosion.

It means *greater* or *above*.

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What is a Prefix?



What does the prefix **auto** mean?

automatic

A device or process that works by itself with little or no direct human control.

autograph

Written by the author themselves.

autobiography

History of a person which is written by that person her/himself.

It means *self* or *own*.

What is a Prefix?



What does the prefix anti mean?

antifreeze	A liquid which can be added to water to lower the freezing point and work against it freezing.
antibiotic	A medicine that works against the growth of or destroys microorganisms.
antiseptic	Preventing the growth of disease-carrying microorganisms.

It means against or opposite of.

- · Include the name of the product.
- Write a statement saying what the item is and what it is used for. Give a LOT of detail.
- · Include a catchy slogan; use alliteration, rhyming words and word play to make it memorable and fun.
- Exaggerate all the positive points of your product using words such as 'best', 'cheapest' and 'most'.
- · Ask the reader questions that will make them think they would need the product and that it will change their life e.g. Have you ever needed a relief from the scorching sun?
- · Say why the reader should buy the product.



Usually, we put 'a' before words that start with a consonant and 'an' before words that start with a vowel.

EXCEPTIONS TO THE RULE

Which sounds correct?



It was a unique painting.

It was an unique painting.

Although 'unique' starts with a vowel, the letter 'u' makes the 'y' sound, so 'a' is used instead of 'an'.

'a' or 'an'?

It was a honest mistake.

It was an honest mistake.


Although 'honest' starts with a consonant, the letter 'h' makes the short 'o' sound, so 'an' is used instead of 'a'.
