In August 1883, Krakatau erupted violently killing 36,000 people in total. _____, the boom of the explosion is the loudest sound ever recorded and could be heard as far away as Australia (4,500km away). _____, a devastating pyroclastic flow sped towards the islands of Java and Sumatra. _____, many coastal towns were destroyed by a tsunami . The wall of water approximately 36m high was created by the volcano's collapse into the sea.

_____, in 1927 a new volcano was spotted in the same place at Krakatau. _____, the new volcano had grown to the size of an island and became known as Anak Krakatau or baby Krakatau.
