Year 3 Curriculum News

Topic: Kaleidoscope of colours **Value**: Kindness

Science: In the first half of this term, we will be exploring the best conditions for plant growth and life cycles. In the second half term, we will focus on magnets and their forces. We will continue to build on the children's previous knowledge of fair testing to plan and complete experiments.

French:

The children will be learning to read, write and say simple greetings in French. We will also be learning colours, numbers and information about ourselves.

English:

This term, we will be reading 'Jack's Fantastic Voyage' by Michael Foreman. Children will be writing diary entries, recounts and letters. Through these writing forms, the children will learn to organise their writing, use descriptive language, present facts and opinions and use grammar effectively.

Religious Education:

The religions we will be studying this term are Sikhism and Judaism. We will be learning about how Sikhs celebrate Diwali and comparing this to how Hindus celebrate Diwali. We will then listen to Jewish stories and learn about the Torah.

History:
