Full Reopening of Highfield - 8th March

Dear Parents,

As I wrote in my previous letter we are delighted to be welcoming back all our children from Monday 8th March. The day to day running of the school will be very similar to how it was in December. In this letter there is the key information and an important change of date.

Parents evening

Parents evening was due to take place on the 17 & 18th March but given the majority of children have been learning at home we have delayed it to the **Tuesday 4th & Thursday 6th May**. This will enable teachers to discuss with you how your children have settled back into school and the progress they have made. It is likely that these meetings will still be remote but we will send you further information nearer the time.

Start of day/end of day times

Start and end of day times are the same as they were in the Autumn term. **We also still request that you wear a mask when entering the school grounds.**

Breakfast Club & After School Club

Breakfast club and after school club will be fully open again from Monday 8th March. Please note that your child will only be able to attend these clubs with a pre-booked space.

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General reminders regarding the school day

- If your child is in Year 5 and 6 and you feel comfortable with your child coming to school by themselves, please let them and email the school office to let us know. This will reduce the number of people around the school at the beginning and end of the day
- Only 1 parent can bring in and collect their child/ren
- Parents will not be allowed on site without a pre- arranged appointment and only if the meeting cannot be held remotely. *If you would like to speak to your child’s teacher, please use the year group email or email the office stating your child’s name and class. For any other issues and enquiries please use the office email.*
- Limit what children bring from home; children will only be able to bring their water bottle, reading book, snack and packed lunch (if they are having one). We will also allow children to bring in a small bottle of hand sanitiser if they wish.
- If your child is doing P.E they need to arrive in their P.E kits (black/navy jogging bottoms/shorts, trainers, t-shirt and school jumper/cardigan) and they will be wearing them for the day. P.E kits will not be kept in school.
- There is no way of managing lost property in a covid safe way therefore it is very important that clothes and property are clearly labelled with your child/ren’s name. This will help us return it to them if they are lost.

Covid-19 symptoms

Please remember that your child must not attend school if they or a member of their household or support bubble has any of the symptoms consistent with Covid-19. Symptoms are as follows:

- High temperature
- New persistent cough
- Anosmia - A loss or change in the sense of smell or taste

If your child or a member of their household or support bubble has any of these symptoms, they should start to self-isolate for 10-days and you must inform the school. If a negative test result is obtained, your child can return to school. If your child or a member of their household or support bubbles tests positive, they must self-isolate for 10-days and your child cannot return to school until this self-isolation period is complete. Please also inform school of any positive test results within your household or support bubble.

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Rapid Testing (lateral flow)

Rapid testing for primary school children is not compulsory like it is for secondary school children. However, households, childcare and support bubbles of primary and secondary age children will be able to have access to regular rapid lateral flow tests when schools reopen.
