Maths: This term we will be consolidating previous learning. We will be focusing on roman numerals and fractions including equivalent fractions, finding a fraction of an amount and adding and subtracting fractions. We will also focus on telling the time to the hour and half past the hour and will draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. The last topic we will be looking at is properties of a shape in geometry.

PE: In PE we will focussing on orienteering using the iPads and will explore areas by using maps.

History/Geography:

This term in History, we will be learning about Ancient Egypt. We will also study Tutankhamun, the pyramids, hieroglyphics and mummification. After half term, we will have our exciting Egyptian day. In Geography, we will explore how place names have changed over time in the United Kingdom and will be comparing them to a non-European country. We will be using maps, atlases and globes to describe the different features.

Year 3 Curriculum News

Topic: Marvellous Movies

French: Our topic will be 'playground games'. We will learn new French vocabulary about a range of activities. We will be able to actively play these games during our P.E sessions. Voila!

Science: This term we will study 'Rocks and Soils' for the whole term. This will involve investigations related to the hardness of rocks, their permeability and the makeup of soils.
