Maths:

We will start back the year by covering number and place value to 100, then moving onto counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will recap our number bonds to 10 and 20 and learning addition/subtraction with one and 2 digit numbers using number grids

PE:

During outdoors PE we will be learning a variety of skills such as ball skills and athletics. During indoors PE we will be practising our balancing skills in gymnastics and learning dance moves.

History/Geography:

In Geography we will learn about the continents and oceans of the world. In History we will find out about the Great Fire of London. We will also be commemorating Remembrance Day and identifying contributions of BAME people from across the Commonwealth in WW1 and WW2

English:

Computing/D&T:
