Maths: This term we will be covering all the main areas of maths, including place value, number and arithmetic. We will ensure that we cover any gaps in the curriculum which occurred during lockdown. The children will apply their knowledge within these areas to help them solve real life/ contextualised problems.

In P.E for the first half term in our indoor session we will be working on our gymnastic skills with balancing and changing direction. Our outdoor session will be focused on Racket and Ball skills. For the second half term our indoor session will be focused on Dance and our outdoor session will be focused on throwing and catching (ball skills).

Computing:

The E-Safety topic this term will be 'staying safe on the internet' with a focus on you tube. We will be using our computer skills and iPads to film, edit and present short video clips. We will also be using ICT to research information about our current topics.

Our topic this term is Movers and Shakers and our value this term is teamwork. We are planning to incorporate this theme into many of the different subjects.

Year 3 Curriculum News

Topic: Movers and Shakers
Value: Teamwork

Science: In Science, for the first half term, we will study Light. We will explore sources of light, shadows and reflection. In the second half term, we will focus on magnets and their forces. We will continue to build on the children's previous knowledge of fair testing to plan and complete experiments.

French:

This terms unit is called 'Moi' and the children will learn to talk in French about themselves.

English:

We will be reading 'Jack's Fantastic Voyage' by Michael Foreman. This term we will be writing diary entries, recounts and letters. Through these writing forms the children will learn to organise their writing, use descriptive language, present facts and opinions and use grammar effectively.

Religious Education:

The religions we will be studying this term are Sikhism and Judaism. We will be learning about how Sikhs celebrate Diwali and comparing this to how Hindus celebrate Diwali. We will then listen to Jewish stories and learn about the Torah.

History:

This term we will be learning about Prehistoric Britain up to the Bronze age. We will be looking at the changes to where people lived and why. As well, we will explore the changing lives of people in these fascinating times through stories, poetry, drawing and acting.

Art, Design & Music: Our Art will focus on the artist Kandinsky and will combine with our music to Compositions both musically and artistically. The children will be using shape, line and colour to express their feelings. In Design and Technology, we will design and sew our own puppets. This term music will be taken by Artis.
