Our topic this term is Healthy Mind, Healthy Me, and we have incorporated this theme into many of the different subjects we will be teaching this term. Our value this term is Confidence. We will be looking at the children's growth mindset and how to develop their confidence, especially in new activities.

English: We are covering a variety of forms of writing this term including poetry, stories, non-chronological reports, and instructional writing. We will also be studying the Shepherd's Dream and The Firework Maker's Daughter. We will support the children to extend their writing and grammar skills and continue to learn Year 3 spelling patterns with weekly tests.

<u>Year 3 Curriculum Letter</u> Summer 2022

Whole school topic: Healthy Mind, Healthy Me

Value of the term: Confidence

Religious Education: The focus this term is on Islam, where we will be exploring the values and practices of life as a Muslim. We will be studying the life of Mohammed through role play, research, and presentations. We will also be looking at the life of a Muslim through a child's perspective and the importance of worship.

French: Our topic will be 'Celebrations'. We will learn new French vocabulary about a range of celebrations and activities.

Maths: This term we will be consolidating previous learning. We will also be focusing on fractions including equivalent fractions, finding a fraction of an amount, and adding and subtracting fractions. We will also be focusing being able to tell the time, roman numerals and 12/24-hour clock. The last topic we will be looking is a geometry.

Science: In Science, we will be studying the topics Animals including humans and Plants. The first half of the term we will focus on skeletons and muscles and healthy diets. We will be building on the children's previous knowledge of fair testing to plan and complete these experiments. We will then be studying Plants. We will be exploring the best conditions for plant growth and discussing life cycles.

History/Geography: This term we will be learning about Ancient Egypt. We will also study Tutankhamun, the Pyramids, Hieroglyphics, and mummification! We will also take part in an Egyptian day. We will explore how place names have changed over time in the United Kingdom. We will be comparing the UK to a non-European country and will be using maps, atlases, and globes to describe the geographical features of both.

Design and Technology & Music: This term we will be creating an Ancient Egyptian souvenir. The children will identify, plan, and create their net using a material that they have chosen through material testing. We will also be looking at the artist Escher and will be creating tessellations and illusions. The children will also be continuing to develop their musical knowledge and develop their skills using the glockenspiels.
