English  
 During English, we will be looking at a variety of text which encourages different vocabulary. We will look at describing settings, appearances and learning how to sequence stories. Alongside this, we will continue with different ability phonics lessons through using little Wandle to encourage reading and comprehension. Books for the Autumn term are: Do you want to be my friend? Rosie's Walk, We're going on a pumpkin hunt, Arghhhhh spider, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Jolly Postman

Maths  
 Throughout Autumn term we will be looking at various areas of maths. This will be taught to the ability of the children. They will be experiencing maths by learning through sensory objects and manipulatives. The areas we will be covering during the Autumn term are: Recapping addition and subtraction to 20, time and place value to 50.

Science  
 In Autumn 1, the children will be learning all about life cycles. They will be learning about life cycles of caterpillars by observing their own butterfly farm and visiting London Zoo.

For Autumn 2, the children will be learning about: What do we need to keep healthy? This will be done by exploring health living and how exercise is good for us.

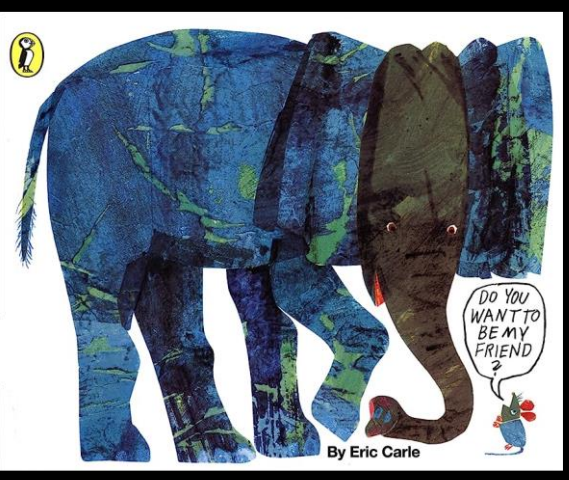

 We will be continuing to learn about coding throughout the term but also learning how to type on a computer and learning about how to be safe when using a computer.

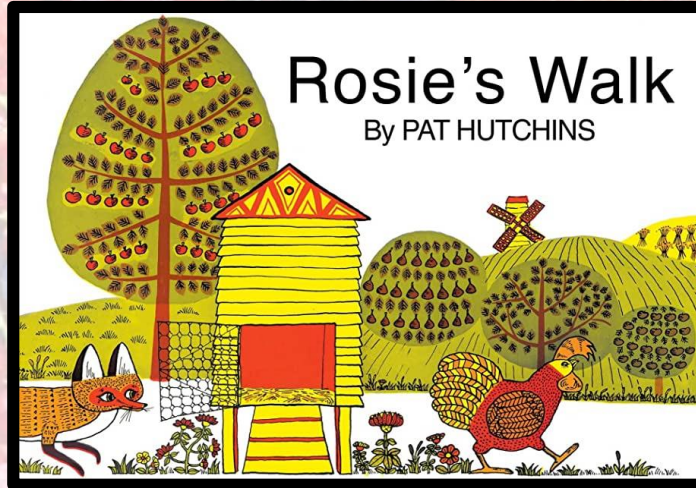
Please be aware that some of the material taught in Berry class maybe subject to change depending on the children and their needs.



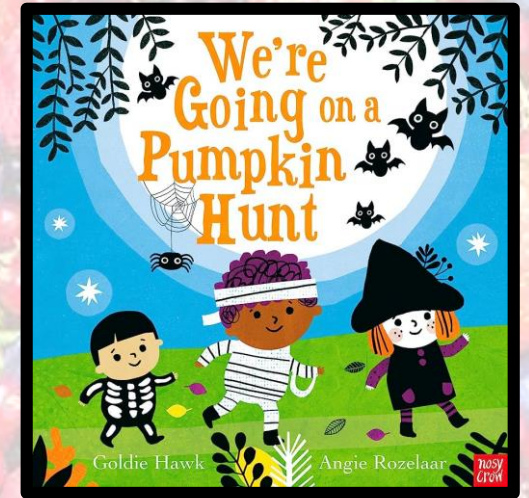
