Year 2 Curriculum News Autumn 2023

Topic: Little People, Big

Dreams

Science:

This term we are studying Animals and Living Things. We will be asking children to look at their local environment for different habitats and what living things reside there. We will also look at what living things need to survive and how we change as we grow into adults.

English:
