Nursery Consultation

Have your say on proposed changes to the 30 hours Nursery Provision offer for children at Highfield Nursery. From September 2024, we are proposing to have a 30-place full-time (30 hours) 3-4 year old Nursery. This is a reduction to 30 full-time children from 60 part-time children and this will support the local provisions to be more sustainable. From September 2024, all Highfield Nursery children will start at 8.30am and finish at 2.30pm (6 hours of provision per day, 5 days a week). Parents will have the option to top up this provision if they want to extend their child's day further.
