Welcome back Reception! We hope you all had a lovely Christmas break. We are really looking forward to working with you all again. Please read through the following information for updates about this term.


Don't Forget

Physical Development:

Children will have daily access to the outside areas, developing their gross motor skills. Fine motor skills will be developed through cutting and sticking, puzzles, modelling with playdough, sensory activities and construction equipment.
