# **NEW PARENT PORTAL AND APP**

We have a new Management Information System (MIS) at Highfield called Arbor. This is where we keep all our parent, pupil and staff details and where we can communicate and organise any payments etc.

Arbor is now ready for all parents to log in and set up their accounts. You will be able to see some basic details about your child and there is also a new way to update your details (e.g. telephone number etc.) when needed. This is also where you will see clubs, trips and consents in future. This will also be used for the next Parents Evening bookings.

Parents have two choices, the Arbor portal which is a web-based portal, or you can download the Arbor app which may be better if you are on the go and also want to receive push notifications to your phone.

Parents who have parental responsibility have access to their child's account.

If you want to use the Arbor App, to set up your account then download the app from your phone (e.g. Apple, Playstore etc.) and log in with your email and the new password you have set up.
