### Geography/History:

During Summer 1, we will be learning about different types of areas we have in England. We will look at identifying the countryside and towns. We will be going on local walks to see what differences we can see.

### English

During English, we will be looking at a variety of text which encourages different vocabulary. We will look at describing settings, appearances and learning how to sequence stories. Alongside this, we will continue with different ability phonics lessons through using little Wandle to encourage reading and comprehension. Books for the Spring term are: The bus is for us, Jack and the beanstalk, The Gruffalo, Sharing and shell, Clean up and Elmer and Wilbur.

There will also be a creative writing week.

### Maths

Throughout Summer we will be looking at various areas of maths. This will be taught to the ability of the children. They will be experiencing maths by learning through sensory objects and manipulatives. The areas we will be covering during the Summer term are: Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, geometry (position and direction), addition and subtraction to 50 and place value to 100.

### Science

In Summer 1, the children will be learning all about plants. They will be growing their own runner beans and focusing on what a plant needs to survive and the different parts of the runner bean. This will link to our story 'Jack and the bean stalk'.

For spring 2, the children will be going back over different topics from the year to consolidate their learning.

### Mainstream

Depending on your child's ability and interests, the children will be spending some time attached to the mainstream class. This will include time for P.E. We will be also attending many school events which include assemblies and special occasion days.

Please be aware that some of the material taught in Berry class maybe subject to change depending on the children and their needs.

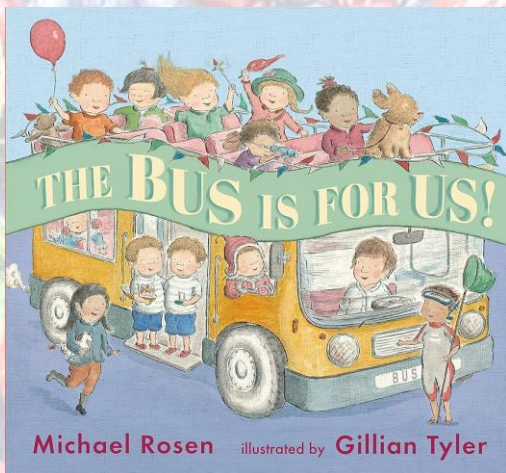

### Art/ Drama:

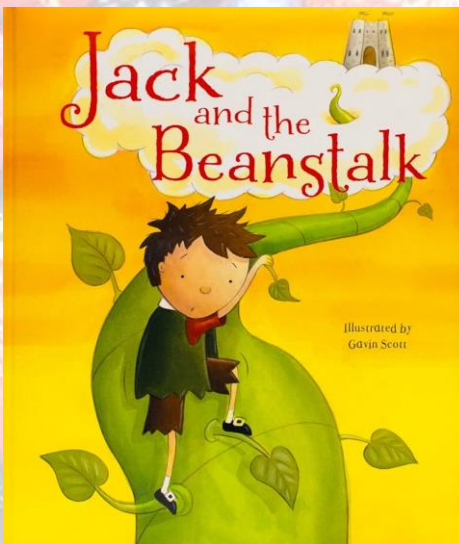
During Summer 1, we will be learning about primary and secondary colours. We will be exploring mixing colours, learning about tone and using water colours to create hidden pictures and messages.

Also, We will be continuing our Drama sessions with Twang each week .

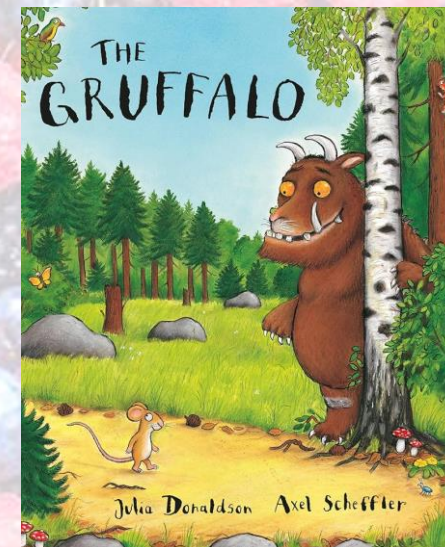
