English

During English, we will be looking at a variety of text which encourages different vocabulary. We will look at describing settings, appearances and learning how to sequence stories. Alongside this, we will continue with different ability phonics lessons through using little Wandle to encourage reading and comprehension. Books for the Autumn term are: The coloured Monster goes to school, My way to make good choices, The bad-tempered ladybird, we're going on a ghost hunt, we're going on a present hunt & The Christmas Bear.

Maths

Throughout Autumn term we will be looking at various areas of maths. This will be taught to the ability of the children. They will be experiencing maths by learning through sensory objects and manipulatives. The areas we will be covering during the Autumn term are: Place Value within 100, Time, Money & shapes.

Science

In Autumn 1, the children will spend time looking at different materials. We will be looking at the different materials in the classroom, what materials float or sink, what materials are waterproof and how different materials are used.

For Autumn 2, the children will be learning about magnets. They will learn what they are, what materials are magnetic and about the strengths of different magnets.

Mainstream

Depending on your child's ability and interests, the children will be spending some time attached to the mainstream class. This will include time for P.E, music, drama or Art. If the children are not in their mainstream classes for this, they will be completing the adapted lessons in Berry class.

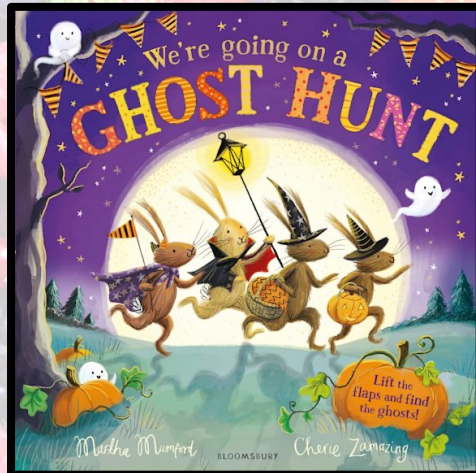

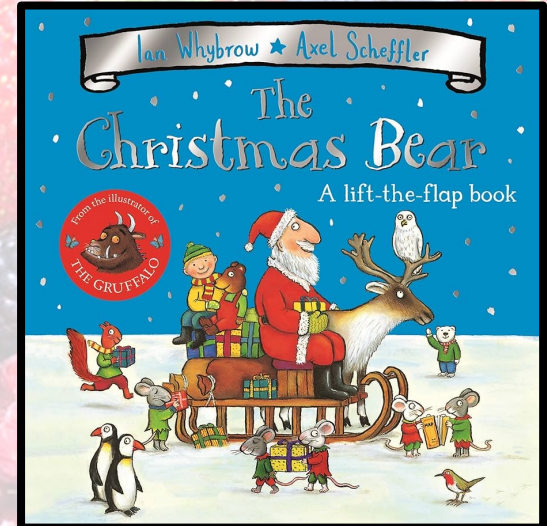
The Bad Tempered Ladybird

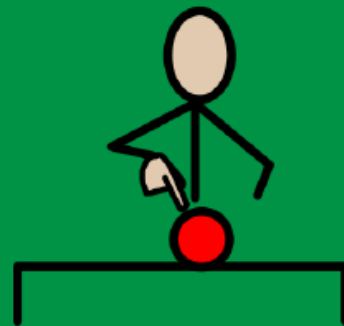

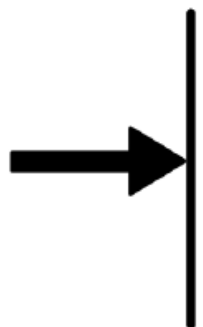
