Spring 2025

Topic: Creative Community!

### Science:

This term we are studying Animals and Living things. The children will learn the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. We will also be studying plants. The children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

#### English:

This term our core texts are 'The Emperor's Egg', "One Plastic Bag: Isatou Ceesay and the Recycling Women of Gambia" and "Grace and Family". We will be creating different types of writing including a non-chronological report and a newspaper report. We will also be making cross curricular links with Science and Geography.

# Religious Education:
