

Maths will include:

The children will be learning and exploring place value within 20 and then 50, addition and subtraction and number bonds to 20. The children will also experiment and explore height and length, mass and volume.

Science:

Our Science topics this term are Plants and Seasonal Changes. The children will observe changes across the four seasons and describe weather associated with the seasons and how the day length varies. They will make a weather station to measure rainfall.

Religious Education:

This term we will be focusing on Islam, focusing on the question- How are babies welcomed into the Muslim family and why is this important? We will also study Hinduism- What is Holi and how is it celebrated?

Don't Forget

Cooking/sensory is **£15.00** for the year. We would also appreciate a box of tissues from each child for this term.

Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle every day. Bottles will be sent home every day.
