Scabies – Whole school screening

As you will be aware there was a whole school scabies screening exercise that took place this week. A small number of possible cases were identified but there were no clusters of cases in any class and at this time there will be no further action from the North London Health Protection Team. We are still keeping a very low threshold for picking up children who have a rash or itching, and if a child is found to have these symptoms while at school, we will ask you to kindly collect your child and have them assessed by your GP.

A reminder that if your child has Scabies, please keep your child away from school until the day after having the first treatment and inform the school regarding your child's / diagnosis right away. If your child is diagnosed with Scabies, treatment will be needed for the child and everyone in your household as well, and 2 rounds of treatment are needed at a week's interval. Please continue to follow the advice in the Scabies Factsheet that you have been sent.
