Reminder re What/What Not to Bring to School

Please remember that children should not bring their own pencil cases, expensive water bottles, keyrings, or toys such as Labubu dolls to school or wear jewellery. The only exception is plain stud earrings, but these should be removed on PE days. Watches (not smart watches) may be worn by children in KS2, but the school cannot be responsible for the safeguarding of such items. Bringing objects from home to school can be distracting for the children and can cause them distress if they are lost or broken. Please remember to clearly label all coats, jumpers, packed lunch boxes and water bottles.

Reminder Regarding the Scabies Infection

In the Spring and Summer Term a number of Scabies Cases were reported amongst children and families at Highfield. Please remember:

- A person with scabies is considered infectious until after the first treatment is completed. An individual with scabies **cannot return to school until 24 hours after their first treatment has been completed.**
- A scabies infection will not resolve without treatment. 2 treatments need to be given 1 week apart.
- All contacts, including everyone living in the same household, must be treated at the same time as the case, so the mites do not pass back to the treated person.
- Clothes, towels and bed linen must be washed at 50°C (122°F) or above on the day of application of the treatments.
- It is important to thoroughly clean the affected person's environment to remove any skin scales in dust. This includes vacuuming carpets and furniture, washing bedding, clothes, curtains and cushion covers.
- Please inform the school if there is a case of scabies.

Triple P for Baby –

A positive start for babies and parents

Aims to prepare parents-to-be and parents with a baby up to 12 months old make a positive transition to parenthood. It promotes sensitive and responsive care before and after birth, up to baby's first birthday.

Delivered in groups, parents will learn ways to cope with frequent crying, set up good sleep habits, read baby's cues, look after themselves, adapt to changes in family life, and more.

Topics covered includes:

Session 1: Positive parenting	Session 4: Partner support
Session 2: Responding to your baby	Sessions 5-7: Implementing parenting routines
Session 3: Survival skills	Session 8: Ways to maintain changes

The Circle of Security Parenting

At times all parents feel lost or without a clue about what our child might need from us. Imagine what it might feel like if you were able to make sense of what your child was really asking from you.

Circle of Security Parenting is an 8-week evidence-based, relationship-focused programme. It is a reflective programme that helps caregivers focus on the quality of the relationship with their child, not just their behaviours. Participants attend a 2-hour group session once per week for 8 weeks.

Aims of the Programme:

- Help parents/Caregivers understand & respond sensitively to their children's needs
- Increase parents/Caregivers' reflective & empathic responses
- Enhance parent-child relationship
- Improve young children's developing self-esteem
- Support parents/Caregivers to be confident

SFSC is an inclusive evidence-based parenting programme developed by the Race Equality Foundation and is designed to promote protective factors associated with good parenting and better outcomes for children in all communities.

Enfield has partnered with Minik Kardes to deliver SFSC to Turkish; Kurdish Turkish Cypriot and Bulgarian Turkish parents/carers living in Enfield.

This 13-week course will be delivered in Turkish and includes:

- Different approaches to parenting
- The process of positive discipline
- Childhood characteristics and information on developmental stages
- Importance of identity, culture, and traditions
- Improving parent-child relationship
