Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. As part of our ongoing commitment to providing an excellent education at Highfield School amidst significant budget pressures, we are continuing our Parent Contribution Scheme to help sustain the quality of education we strive to deliver. These contributions will be used to pay for curriculum resources for all pupils.

As many of you are aware Highfield, like many other schools, has been under increasing financial pressure over recent years and we do not make this request lightly but as a school we are finding it increasingly difficult to adequately resource our curriculum.

**Last year, as a result of parent contributions to this scheme the school was able to raise around £6,000.** Quite simply this meant that the school was able to purchase resources to support children's learning that we would not have otherwise been able to purchase. We are very grateful to all who contributed.

We understand the varying financial circumstances of our families and many of our families may not be in a position to contribute the full amount and any contribution will be gratefully received. **If you are able we would be grateful for a suggested donation £40 per child, per year, towards this crucial initiative.**

To facilitate the contribution process, payments can be conveniently made through your child's Arbor account. You would need to go into the trips section and then select voluntary school contribution. There is a suggested amount of £40 but you can change this.

We understand that financial commitments can be challenging, so we are happy to accommodate instalment payments which can be made termly.

Your support through the Parent Contribution Scheme is invaluable in ensuring the continued educational development and enrichment of all our students. Every contribution, no matter the amount, plays a vital role in supporting your child's educational journey.


