

Maths will include:

- Counting forwards and backwards to and from 100.
- Telling and drawing time for o'clock and half past.
- Halving and quartering shapes and quantities
- Writing numbers in words to 20.
- Multiplication and division.
- Counting backwards from a hundred.
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Science:

Our Science topics this term are: 'Everyday Materials' and 'Plants'. We will be looking at the properties of a range of materials and what plants need to stay healthy.

Religious Education:

This term we will be focusing on Islam and Judaism. We will look at how Shabbat is celebrated and how Muslim families welcome a new baby into the family.

Whole school topic: Amazing Animations

Whole school values: Respect, kindness, co-operation.

Summer Term Value: Collaboration

PSHE:

In PSHE this term we will be recapping the Golden Rules and learning about collaboration and learning together in groups. We are also learning about outside environment and how to stay safe outside.

English text types include poetry, stories and instructions.

Writing skills include using simple adjectives, noun phrases, and sensory details (sight, sound, touch) to create vivid, detailed sentences and using sentence punctuation securely.

We will continue to focus on our reading and phonics.

Geography

Our Geography topic is 'What are oceans and why are they important?'. We will be learning about their key features. We are also learning about explorers.

Computing

We will continue to focus on E-safety in Computing and exploring grouping and sorting. The children will be creating instructional videos that links with our D&T work.
